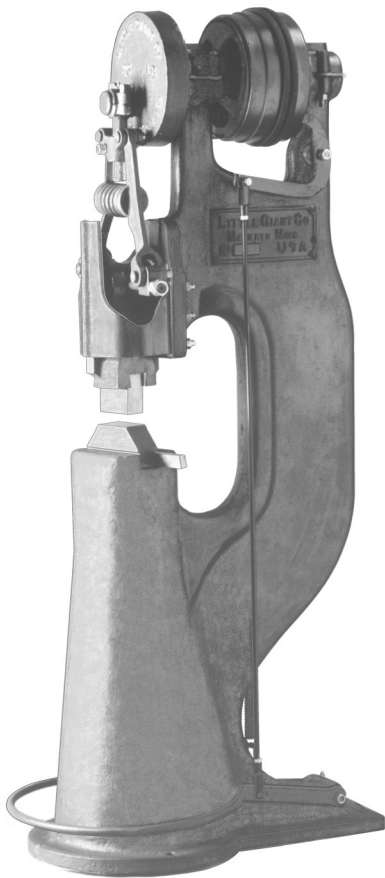


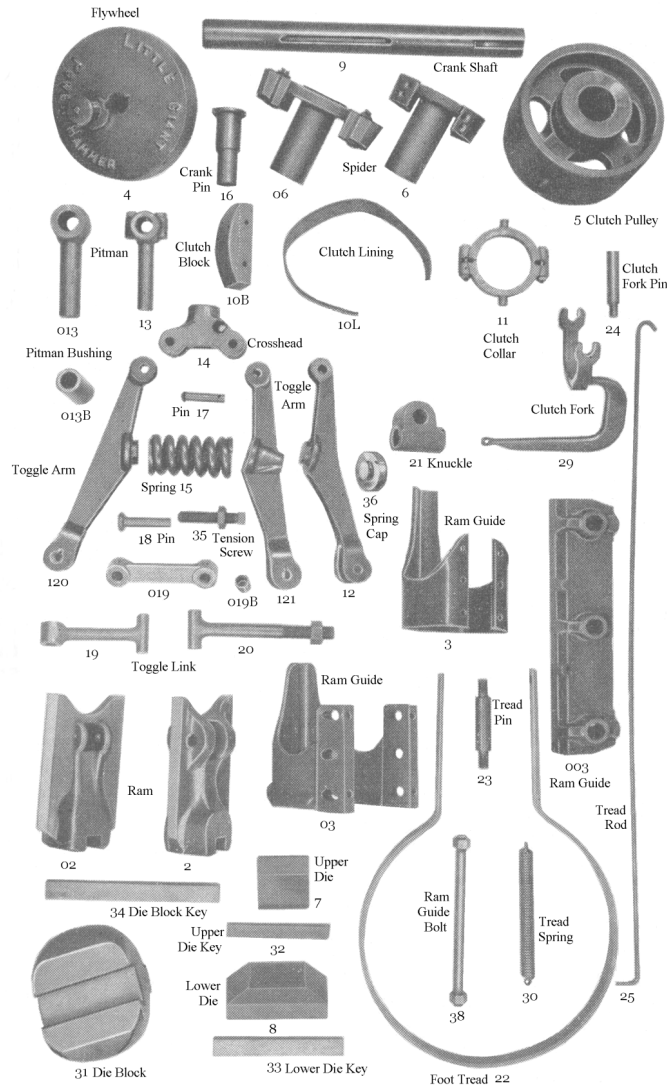

Are these authentic Little Giant parts?

99% of our parts are made from the original Little Giant blueprints and foundry patterns.

Is my machine a Little Giant?

If the flywheel says “Little Giant” or “Mankato, Minn”, it is a Little Giant. Some Little Giants will not say “Little Giant” anywhere on the machine, just “Mayer Bros”. As long as the machine says “Mankato, MN” on the flywheel it is a Little Giant. If a power hammer was made in Wisconsin or Canada, it is not a Little Giant. We do carry a very limited number of parts for the Mayer hammers made in Wisconsin (page 6). Some Little Giant parts will work on Canadian Giants.

How do I tell what size of Little Giant I have?

The easiest way to determine the size of a Little Giant is to read the flywheel. Often, but not always, the size is cast there. The second place to identify size is looking at the serial number. The serial number is a 2 to 4 digit number, usually stamped or cast on the side of the frame. The number is usually preceded by a letter, which stands for the size of the hammer. Some of the individual parts may have letters and numbers cast on them. On very early 50 LB Little Giants, the serial number may be stamped on the spine of the frame or on the cast-in ram guide.

The records always list a date of sale, often the individual buyer's name and location, and usually the wholesaler name.
